REVIEW OF NAVAL RECORD

1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show the lineal position, date of rank, and effective date in the grade of lieutenant he would have been assigned had he been selected for promotion to that grade by the Fiscal Year (FY) 98 Lieutenant Line Selection Board, vice the FY 99 Lieutenant Line Selection Board. He specifically requested a date of rank and effective date of 25 May 1998. His current date of rank and effective date are 24 November 1998. The memorandum for the record at enclosure (2) shows Petitioner agreed to a 1 June 1998 date of rank and effective date.

2. The Board, consisting of Messrs. Bartlett, Ensley and Schultz, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 19 August 1999, and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (3), the Navy Personnel Command office with cognizance over the subject matter of this case has commented to the effect that Petitioner's request has merit and warrants favorable action. They recommend changing his lieutenant date of rank (and by implication, effective date) to 1 June 1998.

CONCLUSION:

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:


a. That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show his date of rank and effective date in the grade of lieutenant as 1 June 1998; and that his lineal precedence be adjusted accordingly.

b. That any material or entries inconsistent with the Board's recommendation be corrected, removed or completely expunged from Petitioner's record and that no such entries or material be added to the record in the future.

c. That a copy of this Report of Proceedings be filed at an appropriate location in Petitioner's naval record, and that another copy of this report be returned to this Board, together with any material directed to be removed from Petitioner's record, for retention in a confidential file maintained for such purpose.

4. Pursuant to Section 6(c) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(c)) it is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
